## Uniform and Appearance Rules P1-S6

The wearing of uniform and pupils' appearance are very important matters. Pupils carry the reputation of Cedars School of Excellence wherever they go in uniform and therefore the uniform must always be worn appropriately and with dignity. School uniform also serves to protect young people from the demands of fashion and ensures a level playing field of uniformity, identity and belonging. These principles underpin our school uniform philosophy and the following additional details and clarifications.

1. Children should wear formal uniform when not on a trip or at PE, which includes their blazers all year round.
2. Children should wear trip uniform when on a trip or at PE. Children may not be allowed to participate in the event or PE if they do not wear the correct trip uniform.
3. The regular days on which trip uniform should be worn are timetable-dependent and will be advised at the start of each year.
4. Where children are required to wear formal uniform for a specific trip or event, parents will be advised accordingly beforehand.
5. Shirts must be worn tucked in. Top button and tie must be done up.
6. Items in the colours or style of any professional football team are not allowed.
7. Tight-fitting cycling shorts, leggings or running tights of any material should not be worn.
8. Shoes or boots should be black, plain and formal. A velcro closure is acceptable on formal shoes. **Note: black trainers are not acceptable as part of the formal uniform.**
9. Children may wear the school trip jacket or fleece, or a navy, blue, dark green or black waterproof jacket over their blazer in cold or wet weather. **Note: this is not a replacement for the blazer, but an addition.**
10. Hats and gloves are acceptable in cold weather but these should not be of a novelty appearance.
11. Children should not wear loose jewellery to school, except for religious reasons.
12. Hair should be in single natural colour (i.e. not dip-dye or Ombré). Long hair should be tied back/braided in situations where safety is a concern (e.g. science labs, PE, trips).
13. Aerosol sprays of any kind are not allowed.
14. Items of clothing must be **clearly** marked with the owner's name.
15. Headphones may be used in class only with the permission of the teacher and must not be worn around the school as an accessory, either on the ears or around the neck.

The Head Teacher is the final arbiter of what is or is not acceptable uniform and appearance.
